William is a representational artist working in oil and pastel. Painting from life, he seeks to capture the emotion of a particular moment and place. Sargent, Zorn, and Sorolla have been influences. He attended the American Academy of Art in Chicago and continued his education through workshops with such masters as Dan Gerhartz, Harley Brown, and Richard Schmid.

William has been featured in Art of the West, Southwest Art, American Artist, International Artist, The Pastel Journal, and The Artists' Magazine. In addition his paintings have appeared in numerous books including: "The Art of Oil Painting, Pastel II, Pure Color: The Best of Pastel and 100 ways to Paint People & Figures". Applications will not be processed until all materials have been received.

## ACCEPTED WORKS

All work must be for sale and ready to hang.

Any extraordinary hanging or installation must be done by the artist, including gluing and assembling.

We encourage anyone who can hand deliver their work to do so.

Artists are responsible for all shipping costs; this includes return shipping.

The Old Court House Arts Center prefers a call-tag or prepaid shipping label sent with the piece. Return delivery costs must be included in your shipment. All shipped work will be returned in original crates.

Work not received on time will not be installed. Artwork will NOT be accepted after 5 pm on August 3rd.

The judge has the right to refuse work that differs from the digital image or does not meet the standards by which it was judged. No substitutions for accepted work.

Work may not be removed prior to September 27.

## LIABILITY AND SALES

Every possible care will be taken with all accepted work and it will be insured for the duration of the exhibition.

The Old Court House Arts Center and the Figurative League will not be responsible for items damaged due to improper packing or damage that occurs during transit.

40% commission will be taken on all show sales.
